Age at Enlistment: 18 years old

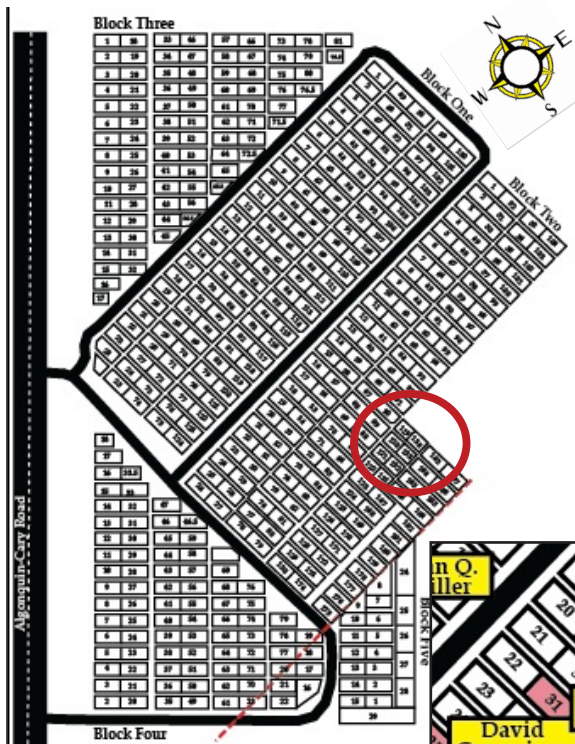
